

## Removing Ink Stains

- **To remove ink stains from hands:**  
Wash hands with an abrasive (gritty) soap.
- **To remove ink stains from white fabrics:**  
If ink from an Inkjet print cartridge spills on white fabric, use chlorine bleach and cold water to remove the stain, but act quickly.



**Use cold water.** Warm or hot water will "set" the color into the fabric.

- **To remove ink stains from colored fabrics:**  
Use sudsy ammonia—a dilute mixture of detergent and ammonia—and cold water. Act quickly and test on an inconspicuous area first.

Warm or hot water will "set" the color into the fabric.



Do not mix ammonia  
and chlorine bleach;  
this creates a toxic gas!
